CCI-E & SIOPE Manifesto for the European elections [2024-2029]



“Cure more, cure better, eradicate inequalities”





Context

- **European elections** happening from June 6-9, 2024
- CCI Europe and SIOPE have been working on a **joint manifesto**
- The manifesto was launched at International Childhood Cancer Day event this year
- We count **more than 70 signatures from Members of the European Parliament (MEPs)** and more than 25 organisations
- We are continuing to approach MEPs and other organisations **to ask for political support and commitment**
- We are working on translations with the help of national organisations (currently French, Dutch, Croatian, Polish, Bulgarian, Spanish, Portuguese, Italian, Greek...) **Let us know if you can help with translation & dissemination!**

Content



We advocate **3 priorities** for MEPs:

1

Saving more lives thanks to better treatments: more drugs for children and targeting specific childhood cancers



Childhood cancer constitutes the leading cause of children's death by disease over the age of one in Europe

2

Supporting the recovery of children and adolescents after their treatment: cancer does not stop after treatment



2/3 of survivors suffer from long term side effects and face other legal and societal challenges

3

Eradicating inequalities among children and adolescents with cancer: accessible and affordable medicines for all



There is at least a 20% gap in survival rates of young patients among European countries

Content (2)



We focus on **3 axes** which are essential to the work of MEPs:

1

Vote friendly regulations to childhood cancer community

- ✓ Pharmaceutical legislation: Unmet Medical Needs, equal access, academic clinical trials, first-in-child innovation
- ✓ European Health Data Space and other initiatives on data sharing across the EU

2

Support a generous budget allocated to health and childhood cancer in particular

- ✓ When negotiating the next Multi-Financial Agreement (2028-2034), maintain prosperous amounts for: Horizon Europe (R&D), EU4Health, Digital Europe

Advocate for our needs during events, in the press and on social media

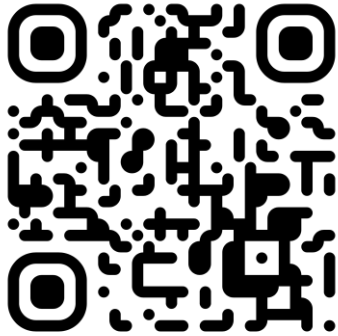
- ✓ ESCALIER guidelines

- Create an **alliance of champions of pro-childhood cancer policies**

2) Conclusions

- Best practices: **our collaboration with our members on EU affairs topics has been very helpful** - use of mother tongue/amplification of contacts & awareness
- **Creating synergies on policy topics**: one contact point per member organization is the best scenario. Exchange on EU affairs, share expertise, and help connect people and topics (EU & national level)
