What is the EU doing for our community?

✓ The EU adopts legislation that has a direct impact on our community




- ✓ The EU approves a 7 years budget (the Multiannual Financial Framework 2021-2027) dedicated to:
 - **Health** (EU4Health: 5,3 billion)
 - Research & Innovation (Horizon Europe: 95,5 billion),
 - **Digital** (Digital Europe Programme: € 7.59 billion)
- >> all these programs support childhood cancer projects

Key takeaways

✓ There are 16 projects on children & adolescents

(+ 88 million euros/almost 1% of all EU budget on health + R&D)

- 3 on **understanding cancer**
- 3 on prevention of cancer
- 6 on diagnosis and treatment of cancer
- 4 on quality of life with cancer

✓ CCI Europe is involved in many of those: **coordinating EU-CAYAS-NET**, taking part in Aladdin, PanCareSurPass, ERN PAEDCAN etc..
