## **CCI EUROPE NETWORKING EVENT:**

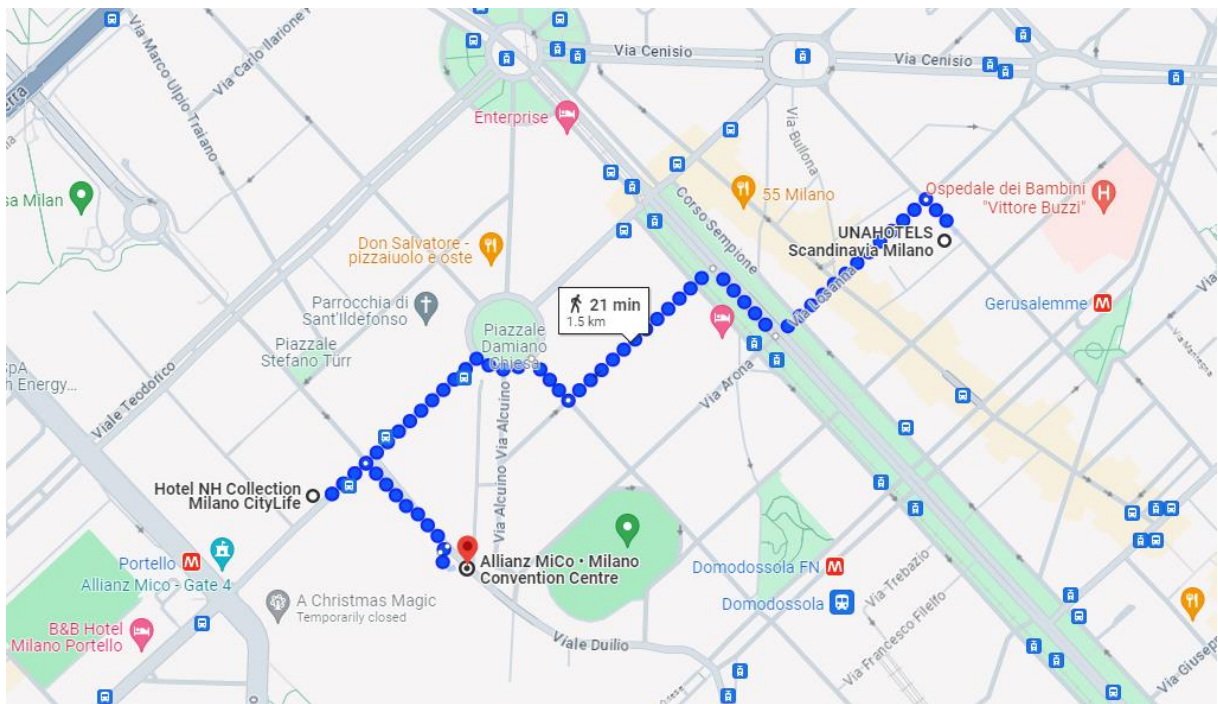
We will have a buffet dinner at the NH Collection City Life (right across from the conference venue).

# Travel

## From Malpensa Airport:

MALPENSA EXPRESS (bus)

The Malpensa Express connects Malpensa Airport directly with Milan, with stops at Cadorna, Centrale, Porta Garibaldi and Bovisa stations.

From Porta Garibaldi: M5 direction San Siro → stop “Portello”

Or

From Cadorna: M1 direction Sesto → stop “Lotto” change to M5 direction Bignami → stop “Portello”

## From Linate Airport:

M4 direction direction San Babila → stop “San Babila” change to M1 direction Rho fieramilano → stop “Lotto” change to M5 direction Bignami → stop “Portello”

## Ticket information:



Ordinary tickets and travel cards



The following ordinary tickets are available with the The Fare System:

- **Ordinary ticket Mi1 - Mi3:** the time validity from the first validation varies with the number of zones purchased: 75 minutes for two zones + 15 minutes for each additional zone. In Milan, the minimum fare that can be purchased is 3 zones and is valid from the first validation for 90 minutes;
- **10 trip tickets:** only blocks of 10 tickets with time validity depending on the number of zones purchased. The trips cannot be used on road services managed by operators other than ATM and Trenord; it cannot be used by more than one person at the same time;
- **Daily ticket:** is valid for 24 hours from the first validation, without limit to the number of journeys within the territory defined by the zones purchased;
- **3 day ticket:** is valid for 3 consecutive days from the day of the first validation until the end of the service on the third day, without limit to the number of journeys within the territory defined by the zones purchased;
- **Weekly travel card:** valid from Monday to Sunday of the same week until the end of the service of Sunday, without limit to the number of journeys within the territory defined by the zones purchased;

Please make sure you know which zone you will need to travel. The major area of Milan is in Mi1 and Mi3. Should you be outside these zones, tickets might be more expensive.

**Please remember that tickets MUST be validated!**
