Why childhood cancer needs action

Each year in Europe, 15.000 children and adolescents are diagnosed with cancer. Thanks to progress in treatment and care, survival rates have increased significantly, but many survivors face long-term health challenges and lack the support they need.

At the same time, cancer remains the leading cause of death by disease in children aged 1 year or older, with 6.000 children and adolescents each year losing their lives to the disease.

Families navigate complex healthcare systems, survivors often deal with late effects, and inequalities in access to care remain across and within countries.

No one should have to face childhood cancer alone.

A world where everyone affected by childhood cancer is supported and able to thrive, free from lasting impact.

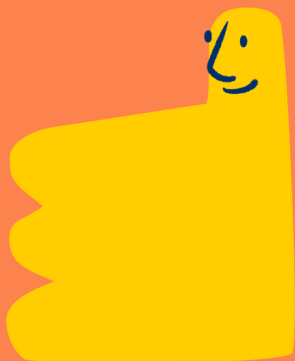
Our Mission
